Please come along to St Peters Church between 9.30 am - 1.00 pm on Sunday 24th May.

As with any task “more hands make light work”, and we will share the tools we have.

- Move the soil from mole hills around the gravestones to fill the many ground cracks that have opened in the churchyard over the years. Please bring spades, forks, buckets or wheelbarrows if you can.
- Trim around the gravestones where the contractor cannot reach. Please bring shears or a strimmer if you can.
- Cut back undergrowth around perimeter that is encroaching into the churchyard. Please bring secateurs if you can.
- Cut back comfrey growing against the churchyard wall on the west side of the churchyard.
